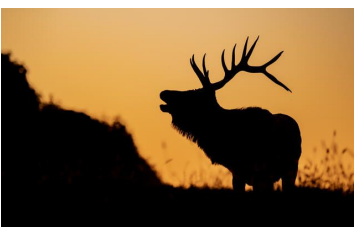

- PALS will provide a red flashlight for the evening hike.

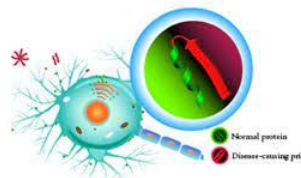
